LSA LUNCH MENU

Monday, Aug. 30 – beef fingers, corn or carrot sticks, grapes or pears, no bake cookie, milk

Tuesday, Aug. 31 – ham, au gratin potatoes, peas or green beans, sautéed apples or mandarin oranges, homemade bread, milk

Wednesday, Sept. 1 – hamburger or cheeseburger, oven fry potatoes, corn or lettuce, pineapple or mixed fruit, milk Or salad bar

Thursday, Sept. 2 – chicken nuggets, mashed potatoes w/gravy, corn or green beans, strawberries or peaches, roll, milk

Friday, Sept. 3 – peanut butter & jelly or ham & cheese sandwich, nachos, lettuce, apple half, milk

LUTHERAN LUNCH PROGRAM

Charges: The lunch program runs on a “pay first/eat later” policy. You may pay daily, weekly, monthly, or for the entire school year. Payment may be made in the child’s classroom or school office. Checks should be payable to the Lutheran Lunch Program. If students forget their lunch money, they will be allowed to charge one lunch for one day only. A child will not be allowed to go hungry because of forgotten lunch money. A “free lunch” will be provided at no cost to students when it is necessary. The lunch will usually consist of a peanut butter sandwich and fruit. Any unused lunch money will be returned at the end of the school year.

Extra Milk: Students may purchase additional milk for 30¢ in the cafeteria. Milk charges will not be allowed.

Guests: We always welcome you and your family to come and eat with the students. The price of a guest lunch is \$3.00 per person regardless of age. If possible, please notify the school office or cafeteria the day before you plan to eat, so extra food can be prepared.

K. I. D. S. – Kids Into Discipleship and Stewardship

K. I. D. S. is a Lutheran Church Extension Fund savings program that helps your child become more fully involved in the ministry of the church.

The K. I. D. S. saving stamp program is a unique method of savings. It is an easy, fun way for children to learn about discipleship and stewardship. The K. I. D. S. Saver will learn the spiritual value of saving, that their money on deposit is used to build churches and schools, and to expand the kingdom of God in this place, around our District and even throughout our Synod.

The last day of the school week your child can purchase K. I. D. S. Saving Stamps for 25¢ or \$1 each and place them in their K. I. D. S. Saving Stamp Book. You may buy as many stamps as you want. The book, when filled, will have a cash value of \$25.00. You may then forward the book to the Lutheran Church Extension Fund for deposit to an interest-earning Dedicated Savings Certificate in the child’s name with a parent or guardian as the custodian.

Over the years, thousands have participated and many thousands of dollars belonging to children have been used to build churches and schools, playing an important part in Making Disciples of All Nations for our Lord Jesus Christ.

K. I. D. S. will be of tremendous value to your children’s future in teaching good saving habits, as well as teaching them at an early age to help support the Lord’s work.
