The last day of the school week your child can purchase K. I. D. S. Saving Stamps for 25 cents or \$1 each and place them in their K. I. D. S. Saving Stamp Book. You may buy as many stamps as you want. The book, when filled, will have a cash value of \$25.00. You may then forward the book to the Lutheran Church Extension Fund for deposit to an interest-earning Dedicated Savings Certificate in the child's name with a parent or guardian as the custodian.

Over the years, thousands have participated and many thousands of dollars belonging to children have been used to build churches and schools, playing an important part in Making Disciples of All Nations for our Lord Jesus Christ.
