Religion: This week we will be learning about "The Good Samaritan."

Phonics &

Handwriting: We are continuing the two vowel rule adjacent vowels: "When 2 vowels go walking the first one does the talking and he usually says his own name and the second does the walking and is silent. We continue with the final silent "e" that jumps the consonant to make the vowel say its name. We are working on writing our last name and writing sentences.

Math: We continue Addition Families and subtraction families with the "six" family. We have started working problems with missing addends where they

have to figure out what the missing number is. Clock work will continue and you can practice on the hour and half hour. We continue our Math Journals where we make problems with a pair of dice.

English: We continue the jingles and working on the five parts of a sentence. We are taking dictation where I will say a sound and they have to write that letter down. We will start doing these on paper.

Studies: We will continue our teeth unit and eating good foods. We will also talk about President's Day with Washington and Lincoln.
